- The business must be in the areas directly affected by the unrest and includes formal and informal traders, social businesses, small retailers, and manufacturing businesses.
- Businesses must provide proof that they were/are uninsured and/or underinsured.
- Must be South African-owned Businesses, or those owners with legitimate/valid residential permits.
